PROMISE

God always keeps His promises! We are a lot like the people in the following joke-a dying man gives each of his best friends-a lawyer, a doctor and a pastor – an envelope containing \$25,000 in cash to be placed in his coffin. A week later the man dies and friends each place an envelope in the coffin. Several months later, the pastor confesses that he only put \$10,000 in the envelope and sent the rest to a mission in South America. The doctor confesses that his envelope had only \$8,000 because he donated to a medical charity. The lawyer is outraged, “I’m the only one who kept my promise to our dying friend. I want you both to know that the envelope I placed in his coffin contained my personal check for the entire \$25,000.”

God gives 3 wonderful promises in Isaiah 46:4. First, he says, I will carry you. Second, he says I will sustain you or care for you. Last, he says, I will rescue you.

The next time life gets overwhelming for you, get out a pen and paper and write down a list of all the times God has rescued you or saved you from something that was bigger than you. It will encourage you immensely to see how the hand of God has been in your life. He is not going to leave you alone in your panic if you will only cry out to Him. We easily fall into what I call “stinking thinking.” When we count up all the times that God has helped us, the Holy Spirit begins to erase all our “stinking thinking.”

“You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you.” Isaiah 26:3 Attach some of the great promises of God to your fridge or on your bedroom wall and see how God will help you overcome panic, fear or depression.
