Joseph Accepts Jesus as His Son

¹⁸ This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about^{*d*}: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit.^{*p*} ¹⁹ Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet^{*g*} did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce^{*g*} her quietly.

²⁰ But after he had considered this, an angel^I of the Lord appeared to him in a dream[§] and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹ She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, ^{f I} because he will save his people from their sins."^u

²² All this took place to fulfill² what the Lord had said through the prophet: ²³ "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").

²⁴ When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel^x of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. ²⁵ But he did not consummate their marriage until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus.^y
