CAMP NEWS- It's time to start thinking about summer church camp. This year our youth will be able to attend camp at Pleasant Hill Youth Camp, as well as Wilderness Retreat & Camping in Lawson and Tall Oaks in Linwood, KS.

Registration for camp will be handled differently this year.

- Parents will be responsible for registering their children by the deadline that camp requires.

- Tall Oaks Conference Center-www.talloaks.org
- Pleasant Hill Youth Camp—Kids Camp is June 13th-15th, cost \$30 and Teen Camp for ages 12-18 \$80 (Register before June 1st for teen camp-early bird \$65). For registration forms for Pleasant Hill see Liba in church office.
- Hammer Memorial will reimburse parents **after** filling out a reimbursement form located in Church Office.
- Scholarships are available. We don't want your child to miss out on camp because of financial burdens.
- On an average, camp fees at Wilderness and Tall Oaks run \$300 per child. Fees at Pleasant Hill were \$60 last year. If you choose Wilderness or Tall Oaks there will be a \$50 per child reduction from your reimbursement. Questions, please contact Liba @ Church Office or Debbie Simerly.


