The Last Sentence

The last sentence in the bible says - “May the grace of the Lord Jesus be with God’s holy people.” Notice the phrase: Be with God’s **holy** people. His great desire is that we be holy as He is holy. God’s amazing grace should motivate us to live a holy life and to seek perfection. Many people think that God’s grace gives them a license to sin. Jesus Christ is more concerned with our holiness than he is with our happiness. What happens to us throughout our lives is to create holiness in us not happiness.

God is not searching for talent or intelligence on earth, because he is the Almighty One! He already has everything that he needs except our hearts. He wants us to be like young Samuel in Chapter 3 of the book of 1 Samuel, with a heart that waits to hear and swiftly obey his word. Let’s ask the Lord to clean his house, beginning with you and I. If we want the wonderful favor and all consuming presence of a holy God flowing in us and through us, we must cultivate a holy hatred for sin, a real sensitivity to sin and a humble confession of our sins.

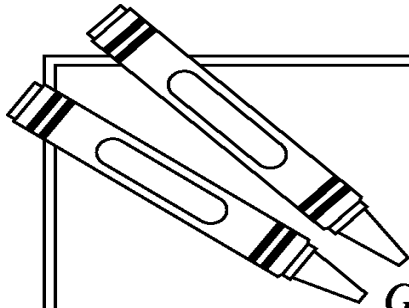

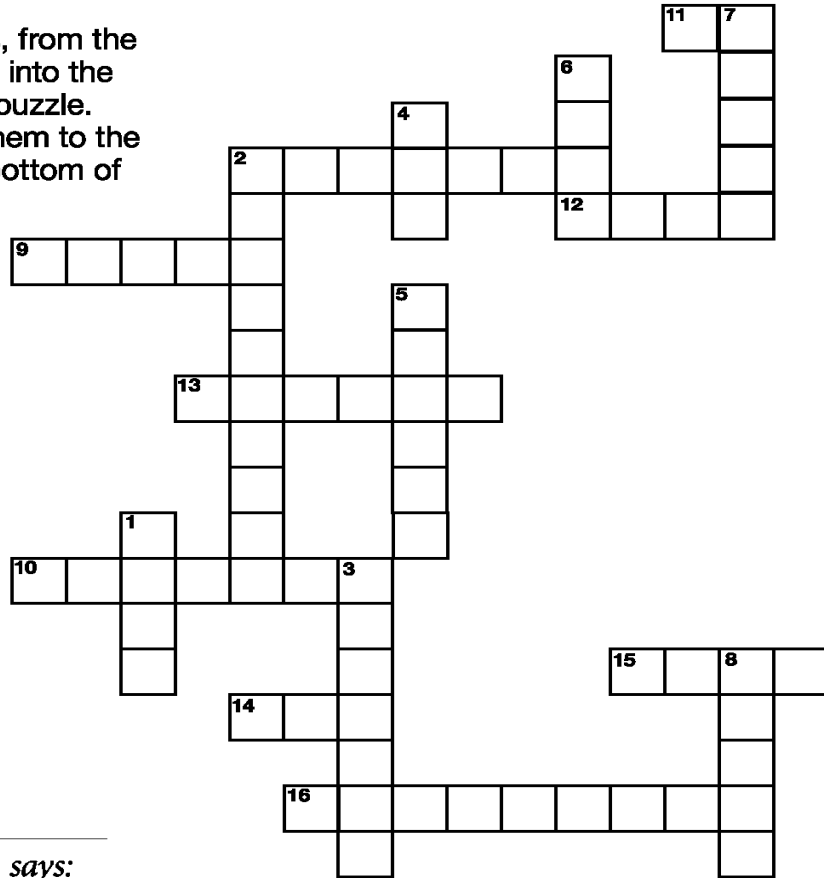
